



Why does Guatemala's rainforest matter to the world?

Use a shoebox or cereal box to create a 3D rainforest model. Include trees, animals, and labels for the different layers.	Design a poster encouraging people to help save the rainforest. Use pictures, bold titles, and one or two facts to persuade others.	Choose a rainforest animal and write a short fact file: Where does it live? What does it eat? How does it survive in the rainforest?
Write a few sentences comparing life in the UK with life in a Guatemalan rainforest village. What is similar? What is different?	Find three items at home that come from rainforest products (like chocolate, bananas, or paper). Write or draw them and where they come from.	Use recycled materials (like cardboard, bottle tops, or yoghurt pots) to create a model of a rainforest animal. Bring it to school to share!
Create a weather chart to compare the weather in the UK and Guatemala for one week. Use symbols and colour to make it fun!	Write a short diary entry about a dream you had (real or imagined), using exciting words to describe what happened.	Draw two characters having a conversation in the rainforest. Write their conversation using speech bubbles or speech marks.
Draw and label the four layers of the rainforest: emergent, canopy, understory, and forest floor. Add animals and plants to each layer.	Using an atlas, globe, or online map, find Guatemala and mark it on a blank world map. Then find and label the UK too.	Use Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars!
