Create a poster explaining how rivers change the land (erosion, transport, deposition).	Create a classification chart grouping living things from a river habitat.	Write a short free verse poem about a river.
Bronze Challenges		
Draw a picture of a river habitat and label what animals live there.	Create a word search using your weekly spellings.	Practise your Spanish greetings (hello, goodbye, name).
