Sketch their outfit and label the key features with short notes.</p>	<p>Build a 3D Vector Drawing</p> <p>Use an online tool like Google Drawings or PowerPoint to create a layered image of something from your imagination – a monster, a robot, or a dream machine! Use shapes and layers like you've learned in computing.</p>
